

**Remit to CPNZ:**

Levin Community Patrol wish to table a remit to create a Maori language version of "Community Patrol" to be tabled at the Central District 2018 AGM, as a remit to be forwarded to CPNZ at national level for the CPNZ 2018 AGM.

The reasoning behind the proposal is that, adopting a Maori language version of Community Patrol will be in keeping with trends within Government and community organisations, recognising the multi-cultural nature of New Zealand society and the fact that Maori language is one of the three official languages of New Zealand.
